## Beginning or Farewell?

The Easter season lasts fifty days, seven weeks, from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday. The spirit of this time is one of joy and praise for the Resurrection of Jesus Christ; Therefore, in our liturgies, we sing the Gloria and the alleluiah again!

This is the appropriate time to receive the Sacraments of Christian Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. Recently, 66 candidates were confirmed in our parish, and a similar number of children will soon receive First Communion.

As the name indicates, these are initiation sacraments because the person who receives them is already initiated in the faith and prepared to carry out ministry or activity in the community. Unfortunately, many young people who receive Confirmation consider it a term, not a beginning. Indeed, a stage of preparation ends, but a stage of service must follow since they are already qualified to serve.

The question for our parish is: What do we offer these young people? What specific invitation do we make to them? If the newly Confirmed joined the service groups in our parish every year, we would have many servers. If we invited them to participate as a group to dedicate themselves to some pastoral or service activity, they might feel motivated to participate actively in our parish community.

Let us ask God to help us find ways to integrate young people into our community so that Confirmation is a new beginning in parish life for them and not a farewell. May the joy of Easter be more complete as we welcome the active presence of young people in our parish.

**Bullying and disabilities**

A child with a disability, such as hearing loss, language impairment, learning disabilities, or physical disabilities, is often at increased risk for bullying. Children who struggle to understand social cues or control impulsive physical behaviors are also at increased risk, as bullies may see this behavior as aggressive, prompting an aggressive response. Children with learning disabilities are also sometimes easy targets for theft and vandalism. In schools, teachers and volunteers should be aware of these extra risks and watch for red flags.
