The Jubilee consists of a period that will be celebrated throughout the year 2025. Everything will begin with the grand opening of the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica on the date of December 24, 2024, and will end with the Jubilee of the Prisoners on December 14, 2025.

Declared by Pope Francis on the date of Pentecost, all of us in the Catholic community are excited and awaiting this great coming of prayer and veneration.

As this celebration is very sacred, we will continue to announce it and inform you about what these upcoming processions consist of.
