## Summer activities

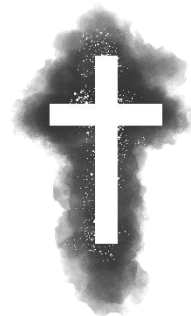

As this celebration is very sacred, we will continue to announce it and inform you about what these upcoming processions consist of. 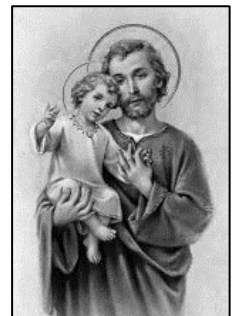

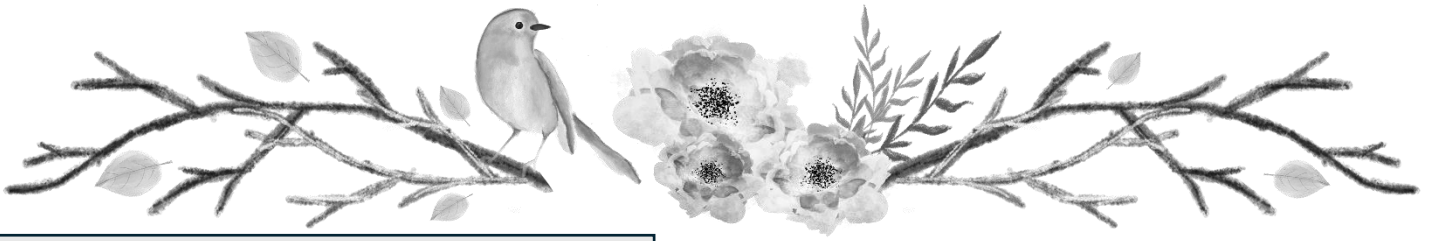
